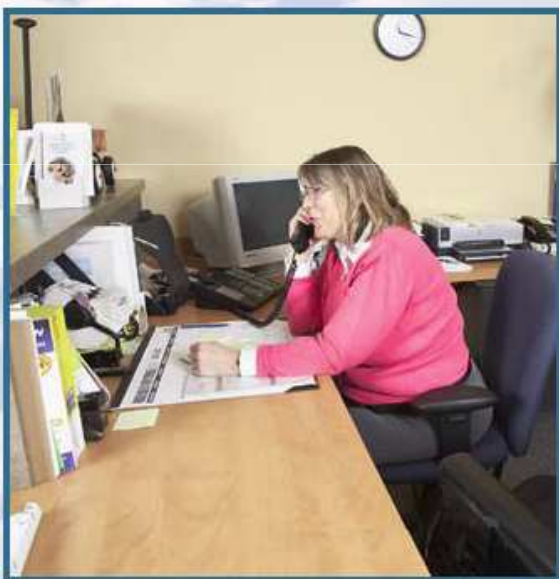


## THE PATHWAYS EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM WILL...

## THE PATHWAYS EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM WILL PROVIDE YOU WITH

- Pre-employment training
- Professional employment counseling and support
- Career and education workshops
- Interview techniques and mock interview experience
- Referrals to related employment service providers for persons with disabilities
- Information and access to employment or education programs specifically designed for individuals with disabilities
- The development of employment action plans
- Information regarding adaptive technology
- Job development and placement
- Workplace support and follow-up



## PATHWAYS REFERRAL CRITERIA:

-  Must have a permanent disability
-  18 years of age or older
-  Cannot be attending school
-  Not in receipt of Employment Insurance for 3 years or more
